What I've done

- On May 15th 2018, I participated to the periodic Leadership Team Meeting.

During this meeting we agreed the following points:

1. The Leadership Team will be **split** into smaller working-groups for proposal discussions, and then these proposals would then be brought to a whole Leadership Team meeting;
2. FXU Distance Learning Officer should be involved for all those proposals that could apply to distant learners too;
3. The amendment to H. Bishop's proposal "The creation of a Students Against Brexit society, led by Harri McLady to help organise student led events related to the cause, as well as lobby stakeholders in the UK, including MPs, to influence the meaningful vote on the terms of the Brexit deal in Parliament in Autumn 2018" that wants to support students to create a grassroots movement along the lines of For our Future Sake, ultimately through our regular Societies framework. This would enable us as a SU to support the cause as they see fit in the same way we would support other political groups;
4. As a student Union, to provide students with relevant information on what can be on the issue so it will be student-led, and how they can decide for themselves their level of commitment to this cause, including distant learners in the process;
5. To lobby stakeholders in the UK, including MPs, to campaign for the UK to remain a full member of the Erasmus+ scheme and to secure a commitment from MPs that the UK will be a member of any similar schemes in the future.

What I'm doing

- I am preparing the document for the next FXU Distance Learning Officer to be shared asap with the Leadership Team;
- I am waiting for feedbacks on points discussed in April 2018 from the new Student Advisor Alice Bonnett.
